British Columbians, hungry for farm fresh produce, can celebrate their local farmer at the second annual BC Farmers Appreciation Week (FAW) at Farmers' Markets throughout BC from July 31 to August 6.

Abbotsford West MLA Michael de Jong and Minister of Health will speak at the event at the Abbotsford Farmers' Market on August 6 at 11 am.

The BC Association of Farmers' Market is excited to co-host the events at the Abbotsford, Burnaby and Kelowna farmers' markets in partnership with Save-On-Foods, a major sponsor.

"We are reminded daily by the media of famine in the Somalia and food shortages causing unrest around the world that food is at the foundation of healthy and stable communities and countries. "This year the event is growing and will be held in over 20 farmers' markets across BC"
