

Squamish Farmers' Market Jury Process

- 1) Is application received by the indicated deadline?
- 2) Does the product meet the requirements of the vendor "Making, Baking, Growing or Providing an On-site Service?"
- 3) Does the vendor have a storefront in which the product being juried is featured? Vendors who were market vendors before establishing their storefront may be juried separately.
- 4) Is the product desirable and complementary to the Squamish Farmers' Market?
- 5) Are there other vendors selling a similar product? (ie. Type of jewellery, pastries, fruit preserves) How will they be influenced? Priority may be given to residents of the Sea to Sky Corridor.
- 6) Are there other vendors selling a product in a common theme? How will they be influenced? Themes include: Sweet Treat, Jewellery, Hot Food, Baked Goods, Hot and Cold Drinks, Farm Produce, Craftwork, Arts, Clothing, Body Care, Savoury Snacks, Meats, Pet Food, On- site Services)
- 7) Has this vendor been a member, in good standing, during past seasons?
- 8) Is there appropriate space allowance for this vendor at our market?

Vendors wishing to add new products to their booth, throughout the market season, must submit the request to the jury for approval before they can be sold.

Upon acceptance of the vendor's application, they will be notified as well as informed about the set-up of the market and expectations of the vendors.
