Health & Safety Protocol for Vendors & Customers

1st – Stay Home if you are sick or been in contact with a person who has been.

2nd – Wash your hands – Wash your hands – Wash your Hands

3rd – Practice “social distancing” – **maintain** 1 to 2 metres between each other.

4th – Space between Vendors will be increased to void crowding. Have your customers pre-order for pick up to less the time spend at the Market. Use Social Media to let your customers know to pre-order. We will repost as well for you.

5th – No Sampling will be allowed under no circumstances. You will be asked to leave if you chose to do so. Use Plastic Tablecloth to make easier to sanitize. Or use no tablecloths.

6th – All vendors are to have a Sanitizer in their booth. Use of gloves will help remind you not touch your face. If you sneeze do so into your elbow and remember to wash those hands.

7th – If possible, have one person handle the money, while the other person handles the product. If not possible, go to 8th recommendation.

8th – Think about rounded up your prices to the nearest dollar to avoid coins. Money is full of germs. Remember to Wash/Sanitize after touching money. Just putting on a Glove doesn't work to kill germs.

9th – Ask your customers/Signage not to handle any products. Have them point to what they would want and as a Vendor bag the products . Less contact this way. Signs will be available for Vendors to post in their booth.

10th – Signage will be around the market as well for our customers to remind them that we are “Food Establishment” and not a social gathering. We will not have rest areas or sitting areas from our Concessions. We need to limit the amount of people gathering at booths.

We must always keep in mind the Health & Safety of our Customers must always come first . So please limited your social conversations & don't allow a crowd to form around your booth. Don't be afraid to have a Voice...
