Grants will begin being reviewed on July 7, and will be awarded on a rolling basis until funds are exhausted. Please note that only one of each grant type will be awarded per organization.

Transportation Grant

Transportation grants are used to help reduce barriers for participants in getting to the market.

We have funded requests such as bus tickets, gas cards, or hiring a shuttle.

You can apply for up to \$300.
